  - Flat, sensible footwear must be worn (no bare feet)
  - Start pulling only when the referee signals.
  - Substitute players are allowed if named players cannot participate on the day.
  - There is no tolerance for aggressive or unsportsmanlike behaviour. Especially cheating or trying to disrupt other teams during their game.
