The committee discussed parking for the floats, and they were updated that coloured cards would be given out to vehicles to direct them at the end of the procession. KK is still finalising the volunteers for marshalling during the Parade and will update the committee on Sunday. He is still trying to source the key for the car park at John Grose. The committee discussed the lineup of the procession, and it was

RESOLVED: That the hedge monkeys will change places with the Garden project in the procession lineup to allow the members of this float to get to activities on the park that they are involved with.
