# What is the Diss Community Emergency Plan?

In a large emergency, the residents of Diss and neighbouring communities can help themselves in a way that complements the emergency services. There are many ways in which you would make a difference, and we are asking volunteers to come forward so that we are prepared for any situation.

## What type of emergency might that be?

Anything where community involvement would make a difference. Perhaps a flood, lost child, a pandemic, loss of utilities, or any situation where the availability of emergency services is reduced. The community's efforts may also be valuable in restoring normality once an emergency has passed.

#### What can I do?

- Become a team member, working with the team coordinator to activate the support of the community.
- Become a general volunteer. We are hoping that lots of people will come forward to do this, this role could include:
  - o looking after the welfare of vulnerable residents
  - o cooking a meal for someone
  - o putting someone up for a night
  - o assisting at an emergency centre
  - o joining a search party
  - o knocking on doors in an evacuation situation
- If you have special skills, access to tools or transport including those that own 4x4 vehicles then please let us know.
