Diss Cemetery – Authorised Vehicle Access Policy

Diss Cemetery provides a dignified resting place for generations of townspeople and is a peaceful place for remembrance and reflection.

In 2019, in partnership with local funeral home, Rosedale, the Council upgraded the roadways and roundabout in the Cemetery to make it more aesthetically pleasing and improve access.

In January 2020, to reduce future wear and tear on site and for the safety of all visitors, the Council enforced its **Authorised Vehicle Access Policy** at Diss Cemetery. This restricts access to contractors and blue badge holders by appointment only.

The Cemetery continues to be open from 8am to dusk every day. Pedestrians and wheelchair users can gain access to Diss Cemetery via the entrance gates on Shelfanger Road (via The Roman Catholic Church) and Heywood Road.

Visitors with vehicles can park outside the Cemetery gates at both access points.

Blue Badge Holders requiring vehicular access will need to contact Diss Town Council to book an appointment. Appointments are available Monday - Friday 9.30am – 3pm or at weekends between 8am - 11am.

The new policy will help to ensure that the Cemetery remains a safe, tranquil, and pleasant environment for all to enjoy.
